

Kellogg Blvd. Construction: Wayfinding for FlightSimExpo Attendees

FlightSimExpo 2026

The City of Saint Paul is completing a sidewalk expansion project near the entrance to the Saint Paul RiverCentre, the host venue for FlightSimExpo 2026. Attendees can expect to see road work in the westbound lanes of Kellogg Blvd. on either side of the RiverCentre.

The RiverCentre doors along Kellogg Blvd. will remain open, and access to the RiverCentre's parking ramp and the skyway will be available throughout the event.

This document provides wayfinding recommendations for FlightSimExpo attendees who are:

- Driving to the Event
- Walking from the InterCon or Hyatt Place
- Walking from the Hampton or Other Hotels

DRIVING TO THE EVENT

- The [RiverCentre Parking Ramp](#) (150 West Kellogg Blvd.) will remain open during construction.
 - Drivers will not be able to exit westbound onto Kellogg Blvd.
- The [Kellogg Parking Ramp](#) (129 West Kellogg Blvd.) will remain open during construction.
 - Upon exit, drivers will turn right onto Kellogg Blvd. and make a U-turn at the traffic signal to travel eastbound.
- Parking rates vary across downtown Saint Paul; we encourage you to compare the pricing of the two options above, along with other nearby parking ramps, to find the best rates.



RIVERCENTRE PARKING RAMP:

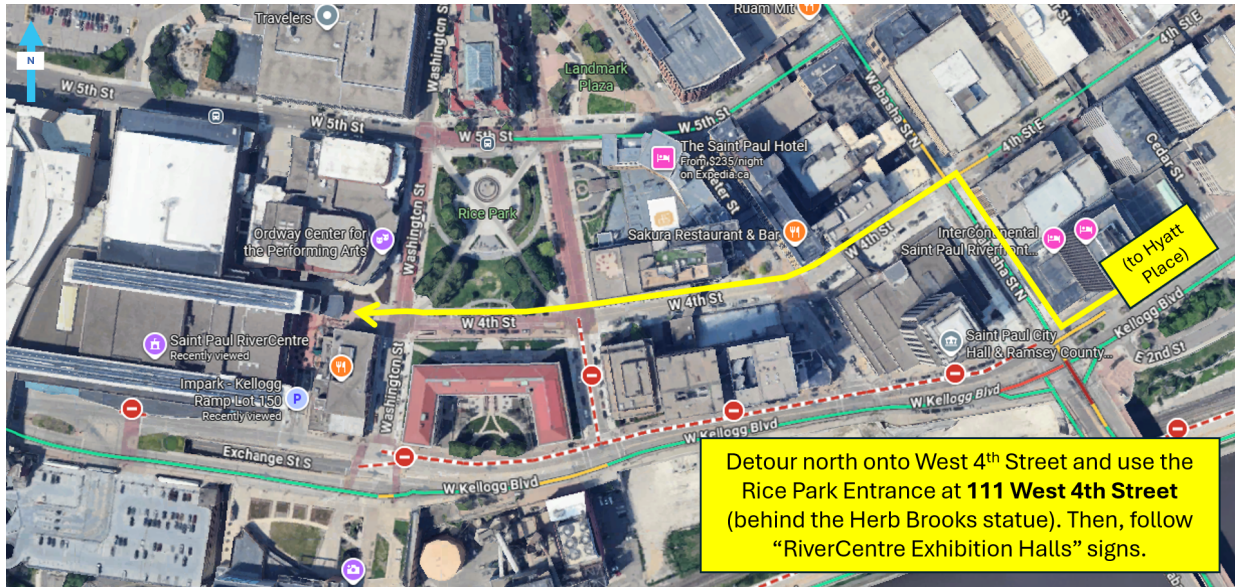
- The RiverCentre Ramp is not impacted by the bike lane construction.
- Vehicles will only be able to enter from the eastbound lanes on Kellogg Blvd and the lower entrance. Drivers will not be able to exit westbound onto Kellogg Blvd.

KELLOGG PARKING RAMP:

- The Kellogg Parking Ramp will remain open during construction.
- Upon exit, drivers will turn right onto Kellogg Blvd. and make a U-turn at the traffic signal to travel eastbound.

WALKING FROM THE INTERCON OR HYATT PLACE

- For the easiest access, detour north onto West 4th Street and use the Rice Park Entrance at **111 West 4th Street** (behind the Herb Brooks statue).
- Once inside, follow “RiverCentre Exhibition Halls” signs and you’ll arrive at registration.
- You can exit the same way. If you exit onto Kellogg Blvd., you’ll need to detour north via Washington Street to avoid a sidewalk closure in front of the library along Kellogg Blvd.



WALKING FROM THE HAMPTON INN OR OTHER HOTELS

- From the Hampton and other 7th Street hotels, sidewalk access is available. Please use caution when walking on uneven surfaces.

DOWNTOWN AMBASSADORS

Ambassadors are available seven days a week from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. From providing directions or making great recommendations for where to eat or what to do, to offering a friendly escort back to your parking space or transit stop, feel free to reach out to the Safety Communications Center or an Ambassador any time you’re in downtown.
